Holy Ground!

(Second in an a series discussing Adoration procedures and ideas)

As you enter the *Chapel of the Holy Eucharist*, **bless yourself** and recall your Baptism. Enter quietly, respectfully, but also intentionally and confidently as a son or daughter of God. Close the door slowly and quietly out of respect and so you do not disturb other adorers. Remember the awful price that was paid to enable you to be with God in this way!

Genuflect. The proper genuflection when the Eucharistic presence of Jesus is exposed in a Monstrance is on both knees. When Jesus is reposed in a Tabernacle, a single genuflection on the right knee is proper. If physical limitations prevent you from genuflecting, a deep respectful bow is acceptable.

In prayer, posture matters. As St. Florian Racine says:

It is by putting one's body at prayer that one puts one's heart at prayer.

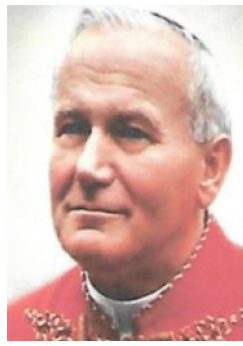

Adoration Chapel Open House - October 6 - 7, 2018



You are invited to an Open House in the Adoration Chapel after all Masses during the weekend of Oct 6/7. If you have a question about Adoration, or would like to see the AdorationPro software in action please stop by as volunteers will be available to answer your questions and demonstrate the software.

Scheduled Adorers and Substitutes

A strong Adoration program relies on its substitute network. More substitutes help fill regular Adorers' times when needed. This makes the entire program better and stronger. We know some people are hesitant to commit to a scheduled Adoration hour because they may not be present every week. Substitutes benefit from their Adoration time and help other Adorers to commit to scheduled times.

The way AdorationPro software handles substitute requests is one of its strongest features. A substitute specifies the exact hours and days they are available. When a scheduled Adorer requests a sub, the software matches the Adorer's time slot to the list of subs matching that time and sends an email request to only those subs. When a sub accepts the request, the system blocks other potential subs from accepting that same request. Both the Adorer and sub receive confirmation emails recapping the transaction. If a sub receives an email request and cannot help at that time, they simply ignore the email.

Immaculate Heart of Mary's Adoration program currently has 39 substitutes. ***We also need additional help for more regular Adorers and substitutes between Midnight and 6 AM everyday.***

AdorationPro software works well if sub requests are made within 14 days of the date needed. The closer to the time needed, the quicker the response. Requests made for more than 14 days in advance are generally 'slow' to be accepted. We suggest if you request a sub more than 14 days in advance, or for an extended period of time, you use the old fashion manual contact method.

If you waited more than 7 days for a response to your sub request, it is suggested you call or email from the manual list, or you submit another electronic request.

Very important note: The act of submitting a sub request through AdorationPro does not alleviate the Adorer from finding a sub. You must get a positive response for your request to make sure someone covers your Adoration hour.

A sub list and contact information is available within the AdorationPro software. Log on to AdorationPro, click on the "Find A Sub" tab. Enter the password "subpass" to access this information. A paper list of subs is also available in the Prayer Intention book in the chapel for people without email or Internet.

If more than one person is assigned to your Adoration hour, you should first contact your "prayer partner" and verify they will be there when you are gone. The goal is to have a minimum of two people assigned to every hour, but only one needs to be there.

When a sub signs into the kiosk they can choose to click the name of the person they are subbing for, or they can register as a 'visitor'.

Thank you to all regular Adorers and to the many people volunteering to be substitutes for your work and dedication to the success of this ministry. The personal blessings and blessings to our parish as a result of Adoration are immeasurable.
