Dear Sponsor,

Congratulations on being asked to be a Confirmation sponsor! It is a blessing, an honor & a great responsibility to be chosen to assist a candidate as they continue to discover & deepen their faith. This letter will serve as a guide for you to know what a sponsor is & what is expected of you. Thank you for considering this opportunity.

What is a sponsor?

A sponsor is intended to be a spiritual guide & mentor to the Confirmation candidate. (Catechism 1311). They are a representative of the church community who will support & guide the candidate as they embark on the full sacramental life in the Church. During the preparation for Confirmation, the sponsor should build a strong spiritual relationship with the candidate because the role is not ceremonial, it is intended to be a lifelong commitment!

The sponsor's role according to the Code of Canon Law (892), "is to take care that the confirmed person behaves as a true witness of Christ & faithfully fulfills the obligations inherent in this sacrament." Good sponsorship flows from walking with the candidate, sharing your own faith story & experience, and listening to his or her story. As you accompany your candidate throughout the preparation process, your role includes affirming the strengths of your candidate & pointing out ways he or she can grow & become better in the practice of faith.

Traits of a Sponsor –
☐ An active faith life
☐ Consistent prayer life
☐ Attend Mass Every Sunday
☐ Frequent Reconciliation
☐ Live a Catholic life committed to moral choices guided by faith
☐ Mentor
☐ Empathetic listening
Sponsor's Checklist
☐ Fill out & submit the attached Sponsor Form by March 4th
☐ Write a Recommendation Letter for your Confirmand (confirmation candidate) June 4th
☐ Mark the date of the celebration of Confirmation in your calendar
☐ Meet at least monthly to discuss your candidate's faith journey
☐ Pray with ℰ for your candidate
☐ Find a service project to complete with your candidate (serve the Church together)
☐ Encourage your candidate to attend Sunday Mass & reconciliation

	☐ What is something new you have learned about the Catholic faith recently?
	☐ How do you pray? What are some places you pray? Do you have specific prayers you like?
	☐ What are some obstacles you face when it comes to prayer?
	☐ Do you believe you are loved by God?
	\square What are some struggles you have with Church teaching? Are there any topics you would
	like to know more about?
	☐ How do you feel about going to Mass? Is there anything you do not understand?
	☐ Which gift of the Holy Spirit would you most like to possess?
	\square Share an experience from the past 24 hours where you recognize the Holy Spirit's presence
So	ome Activities / Challenges to offer your candidate –
	☐ Go to confession (offer to take them if you are comfortable)
	☐ Journal for 10–15 minutes each day
	☐ Try Lectio Divina
	☐ Start your day thanking God
	☐ Try fasting one day a week
	☐ Pray a rosary once per week
	☐ Spend 10 minutes in silence daily
	☐ Spend 10 minutes in pray – offering God the good moments & the bad
	☐ Go to adoration – try to go together!
